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SYMBOL

The ENS symbol is the main icon and mark for ENS, that has its derivations from Ethereum.

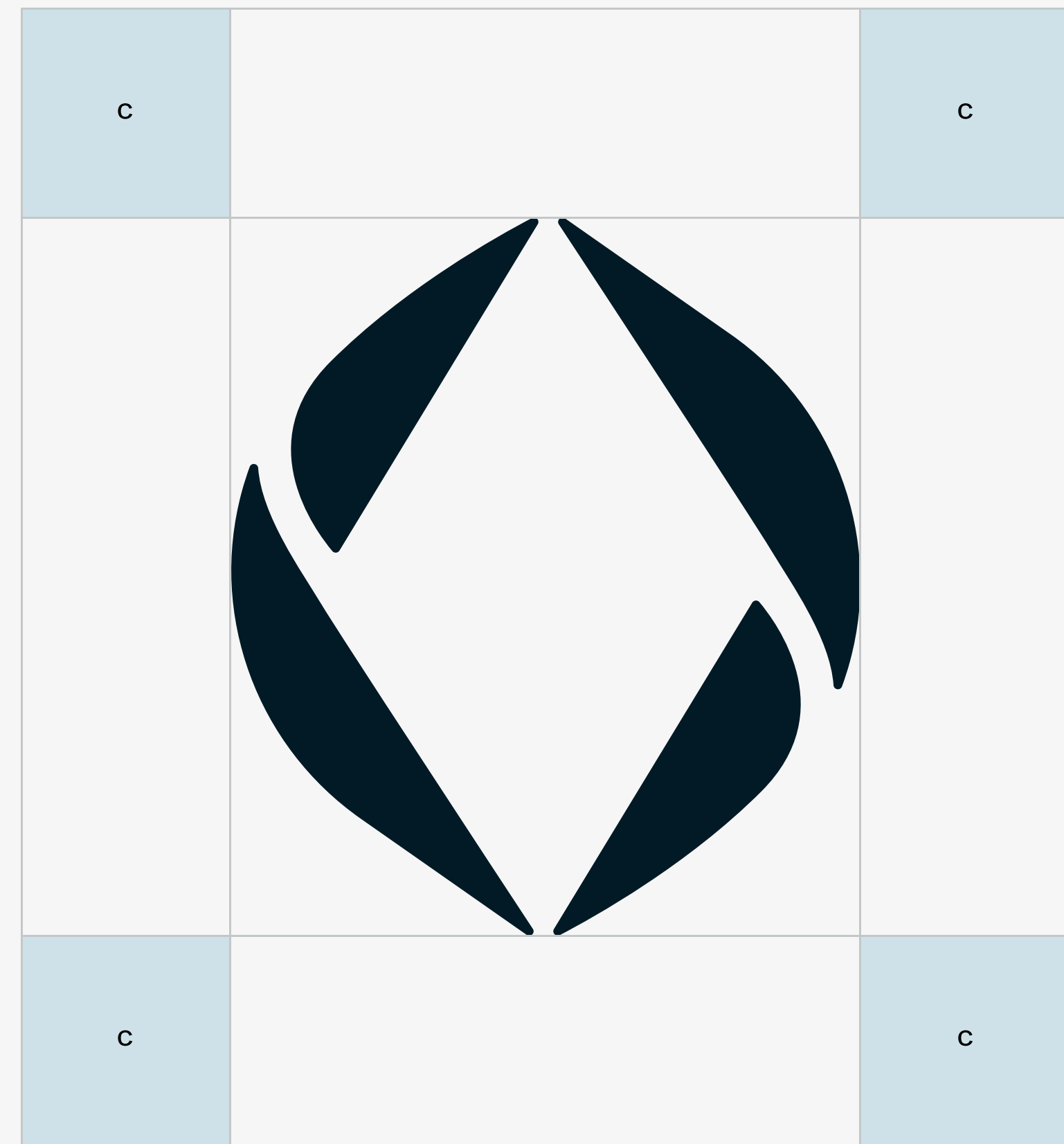


The petals have been redrawn for the 2024 brand refresh, such that it feels a touch more soft and balanced with its rounded corners.

CLEARSPACE

Below is the recommended clearspace area (extra space you should leave such that the logo feels evenly weighted inside a composition) when placing the symbol on a composition.

FULL LOCK-UP

This is the main lock-up for ENS, and is crafted using the main symbol and a custom rounded version of ABC Monument Grotesk.

The lowercase “e” is slightly tilted, and the legs of the “n” have been decreased ever so slightly to contrast well optically.



FULL LOCK-UP CLEARSPACE

Below is the recommended clearspace area (extra space you should leave such that the logo feels evenly weighted inside a composition) when placing the full-lock-up, equal to the space between the mark and the wordmark.

There are rare exceptions to this rule (think about when you are laying it out really big), but when in doubt, stick with this clearspace rule.



SPACE BETWEEN SYMBOL AND WORDMARK IS THE WIDTH OF THE LEG OF THE “N”.

VERTICAL LOCK-UP

For special and alternative use-cases, we have a vertical lock-up.

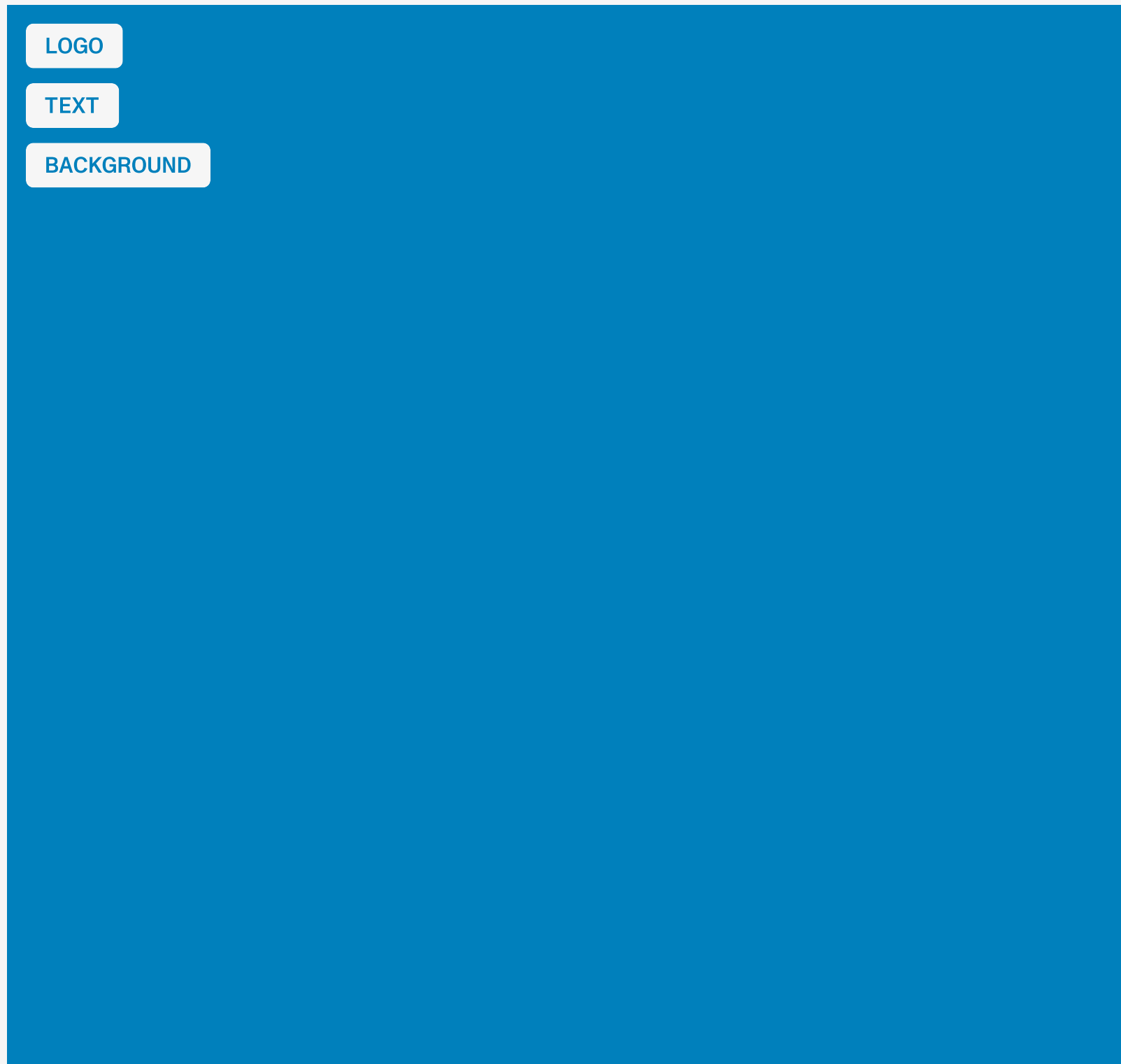

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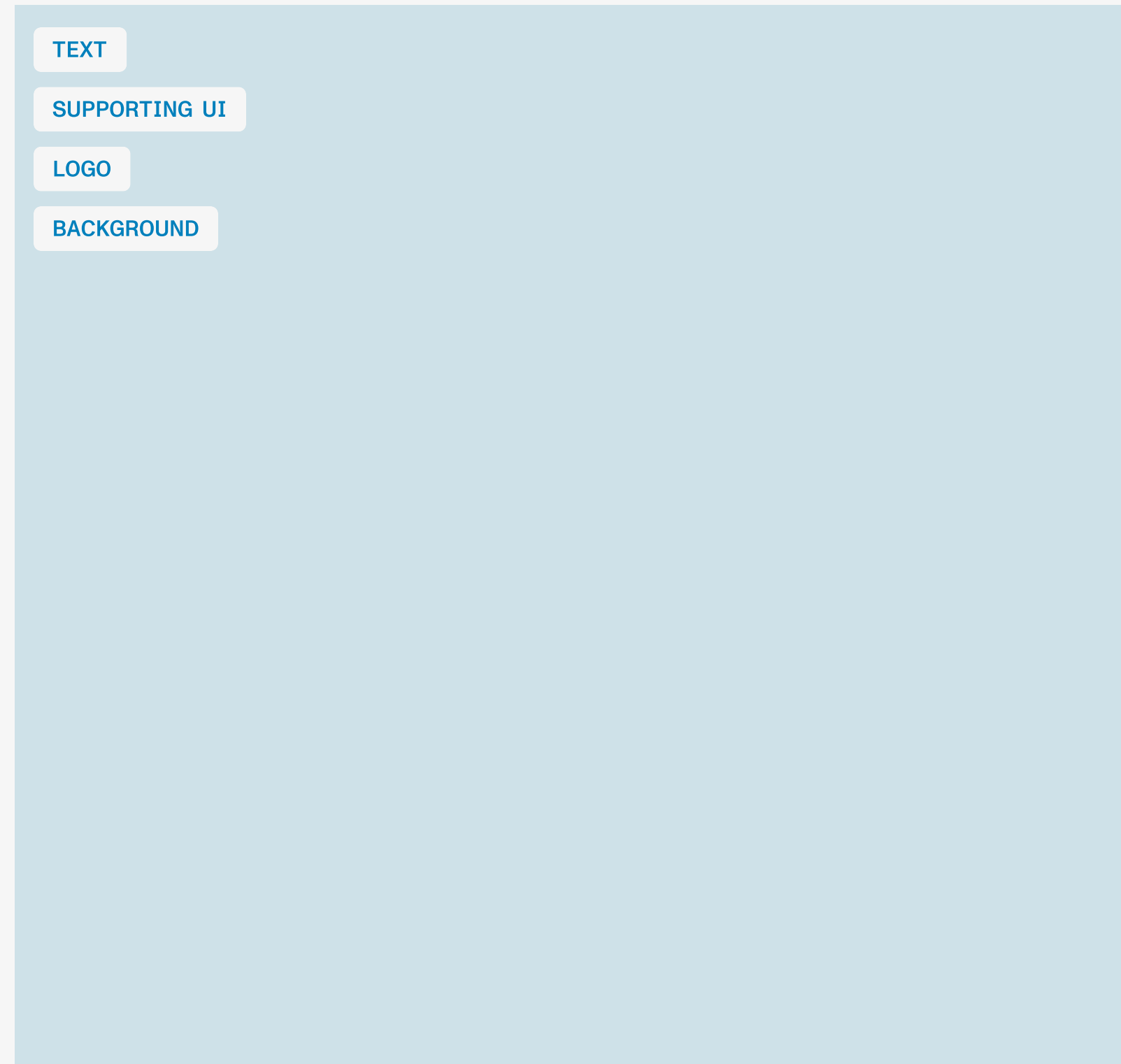
PRIMARY COLOR PALETTE

Below is the primary color palette for the ENS brand. Please keep in mind that the colors are not a “one-size-fits-all” and use your best judgement on creating net-new assets for ENS.

The “ENS Blue” color is the main color to use for a variety of things core branded — logo, text, and background (when you need a saturated background fill).



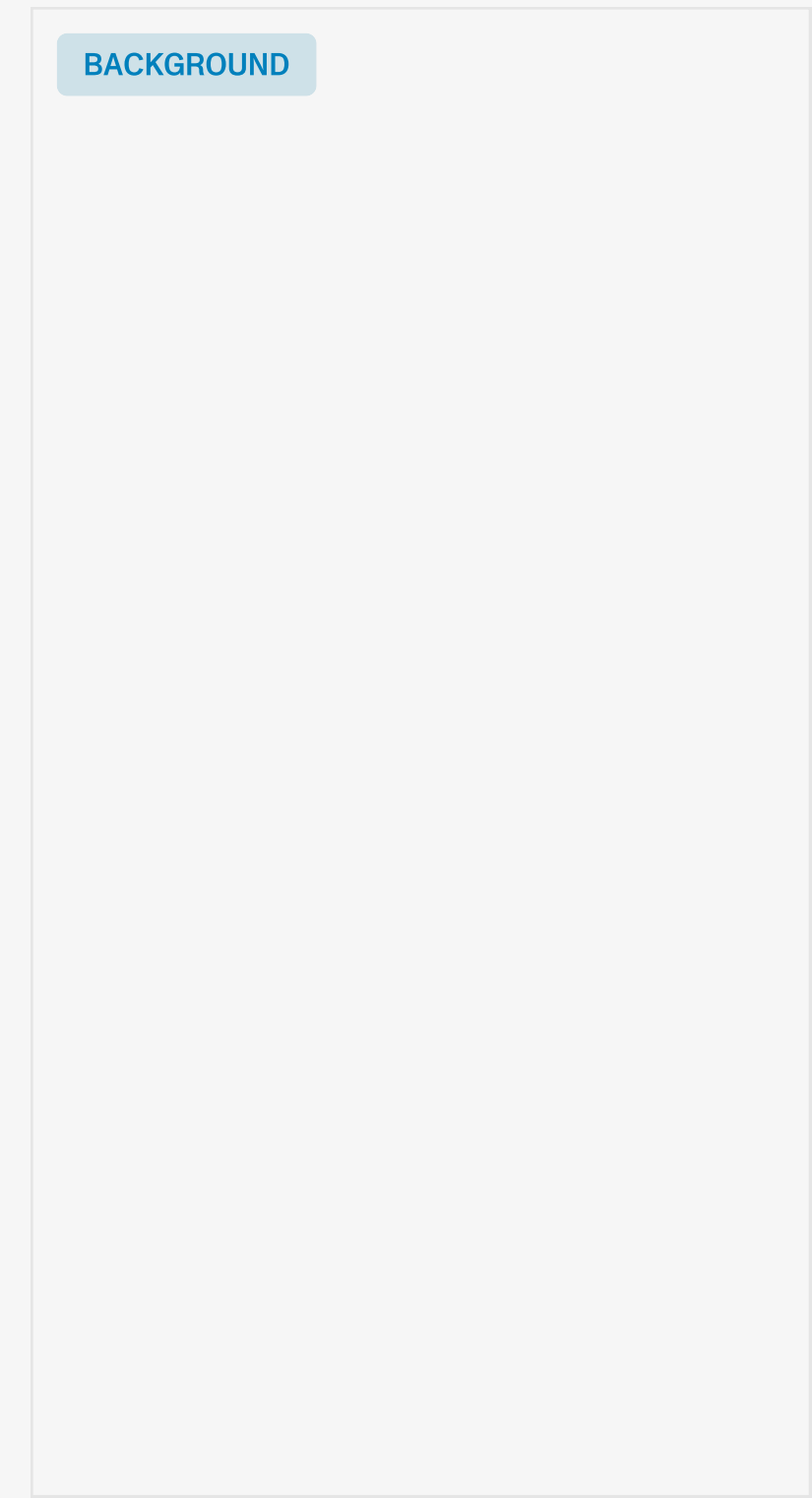

“Light Blue” can be used as a supporting color to use on the logo (when paired with a dark background), supporting UI elements, and a background (usually paired with the ENS Blue).

“Dark Blue” is a more accessible color to be used on the text, logo, and background.

TYPE PAIRINGS

Below are example pairings for the ENS typographic system.

As a good rule of thumb, the smaller the font size, the more relaxed the letterspacing, and as the size increases, the letterspacing decreases.

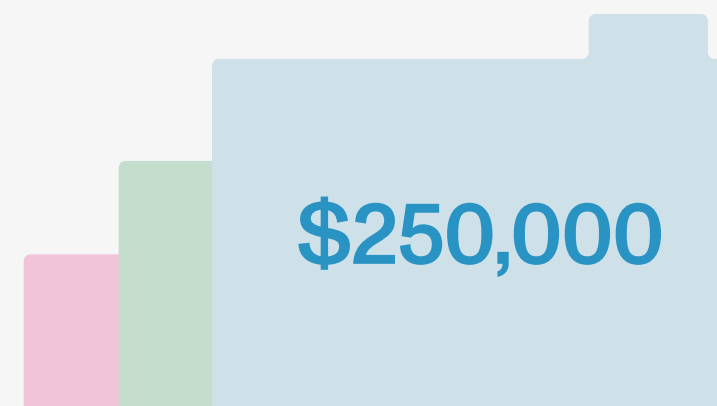

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PATHWAYS

What are pathways?

Pathways are guiding lines and visual abstractions. Graphically, we use these pathways to tell visual stories or at the least, serve as a guiding supporting visual anchor for our branded collateral.

As far as tips for using the pathways,
it's a little bit of feel, but in general,
try to use them feeling "zoomed in"
and not showing too much of the
full pathway.

These were originally created using
Adobe Illustrator, and is created by
using thin strokes, and off-set path.



SNIPPETS

Snippets are intended to be used mainly for the website and smaller pieces of collateral, and are used in areas where the “pathways” might feel too large.

1. SINGULAR PATHWAY

The pathway here should always be in an even spot (with equal padding accordingly).

It should have a very narrow inner-line.

2. CHECKPOINT

The “checkpoint” here (rounded square node to signify a user’s movements) is optional here.

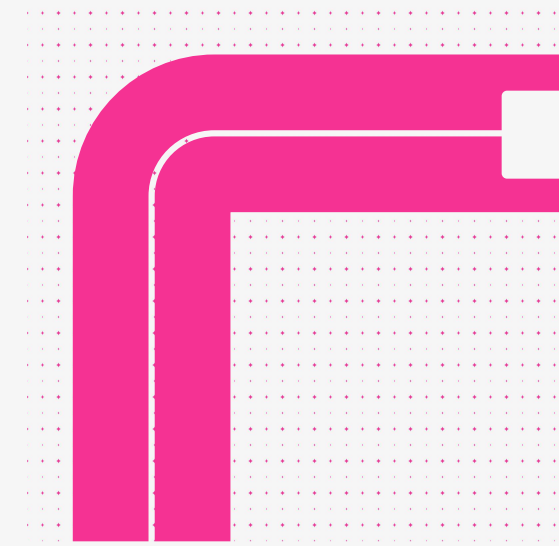
Try not to use too many snippets that include the nodes here when using more than one snippet.

3. BACKGROUND

The background has a tiled tonal fill, and should match the fill of the foreground pathway (in this case, ENS Blue).

They provide a taste of the pathways, and can be used as supporting visuals to highlight a headline or a subhead.

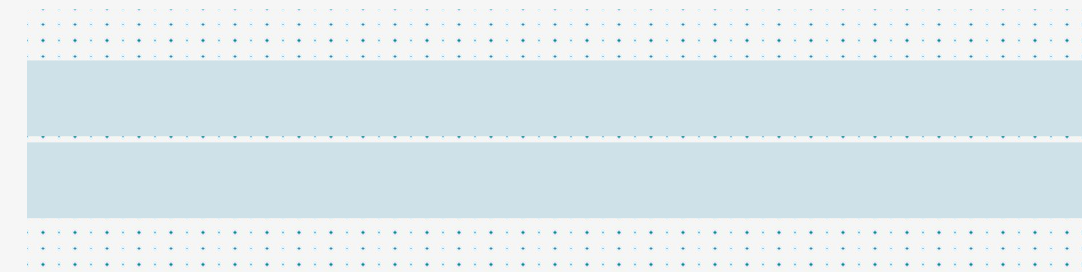

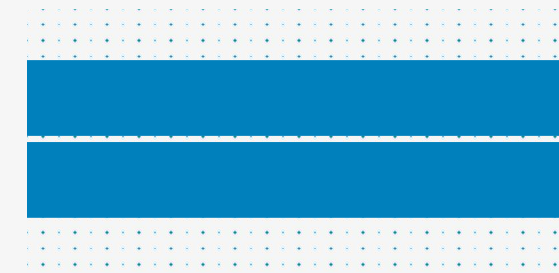

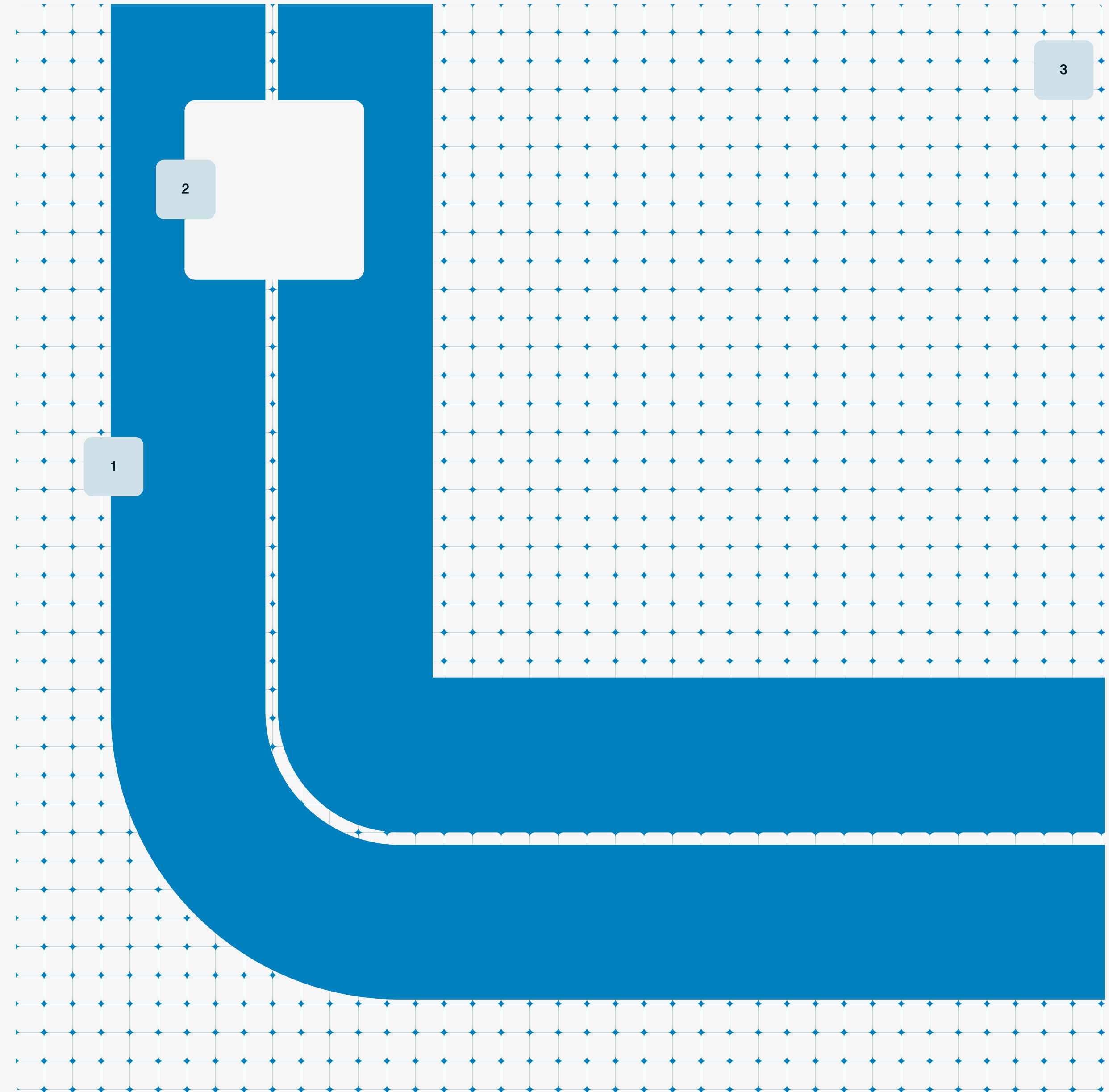
